Parental consent for abortion is not required in the state of Illinois. No one will be given information about your visit without your written permission or unless required to by law. Illinois does not have a waiting period for abortion care.




 American Women's Medical Group – Performs abortions up to 17 ¹/₂ weeks. (773) 772-7727

Family Planning Associates Medical Group –

Provides abortions through 23 ¹/₂ weeks. This clinic will assist with funding the abortion. (312) 707-8988

 University of Illinois Medical Center, Center for Reproductive Health – Provides abortions through 23 weeks and 6 days. May be able to go further if extenuating circumstances. Can usually get people scheduled and seen within a week. (312) 413-8553
