New Mexico has no parental consent requirement or waiting period.



### PP of Rocky Mountains

Planned Parenthood may have its own source of funding as well. Have patient ask clinic when they make an appointment.

- WRRAP Clinic must have a relationship with WRRAP and the clinic will have to contact WRRAP. Patients should ask clinic if they have a relationship with WRRAP.
- Mariposa Fund Funds abortions and practical support for undocumented people going to Southwestern Women's. (505) 242-7512
- The Brigid Alliance Only provides assistance for people who are 15+ weeks pregnant and going to Southwestern Women's. The clinic will have to make the referral and patient can't contact fund on their own. Helps pay for practical support.
