New Mexico has no parental consent requirement or waiting period.

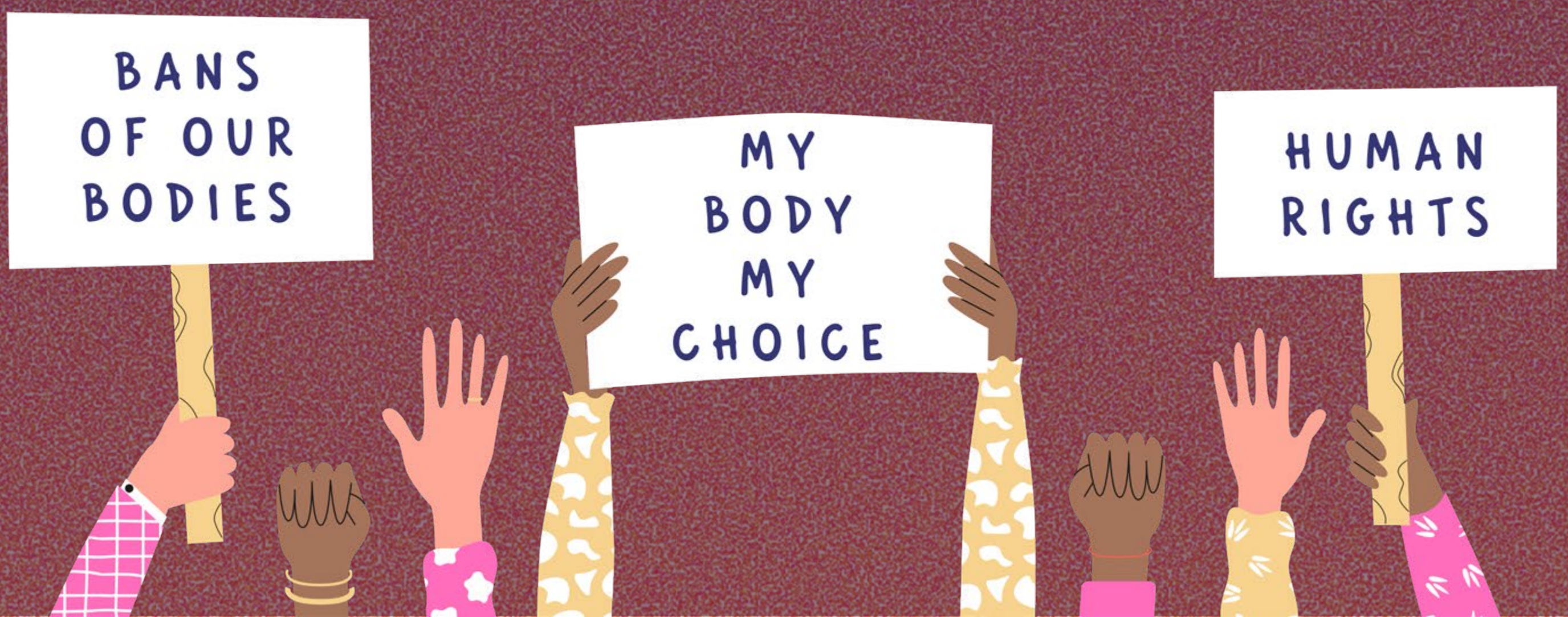
Clinics in New Mexico:

- **Southwestern Women's** – Performs abortions through 23 weeks, 6 days. (505) 242-9592
- **UNM Center for Reproductive Health** – Performs abortions through 23 weeks, 6 days. (505) 925-4455
- **Alamo Women's Clinic** – Performs abortions through 18 weeks. (505) 494-5700

PP of Rocky Mountains

Planned Parenthood may have its own source of funding as well. Have patient ask clinic when they make an appointment.

- **San Mateo Health Center** – Performs abortions 19 weeks, 6 days. (505) 265-9511
- **Santa Fe Health Center** – Abortion Pill up to 11 weeks (505) 982-3684

Other organizations that provide funding:

- **New Mexico Religious Coalition for Reproductive Choice** – Will help with practical support. Must have a confirmed appointment at New Mexico clinic.

- **NAF Hotline Fund** - Only if going to a NAF certified clinic and will need an appointment with a clinic and the cost of the procedure. Will help with cost of abortion and practical support. All New Mexico clinics listed above are NAF certified except Alamo Women's Clinic.

- **WRRAP** – Clinic must have a relationship with WRRAP and the clinic will have to contact WRRAP. Patients should ask clinic if they have a relationship with WRRAP.
- **Mariposa Fund** – Funds abortions and practical support for undocumented people going to Southwestern Women's. (505) 242-7512
- **The Brigid Alliance** – Only provides assistance for people who are 15+ weeks pregnant and going to Southwestern Women's. The clinic will have to make the referral and patient can't contact fund on their own. Helps pay for practical support.
